



# Movie Magic Budgeting

### **WHAT'S NEW IN THIS RELEASE**

---

#### **Enhancements**

- Auto Complete is now available in the Currency column.
- Sub Total is now available in the Amount Column.

#### **Printing**

- 64bit printing issues have been resolved on both Mac® and Windows®.
- Column minimums have been adjusted to allow more content.
- Page number column on the Top Sheet displays correctly.
- Blank pages have been removed from printed reports.
- Reports now print when text wrap is selected.
- Print preview displays budget when both line number and text wrap are selected.
- Account Header row in the Detail Report is now properly bolded when text wrap has been selected.
- In Budget Comparison the Applied Credit now displays parenthesis for negative sums.
- Aggregate fringe column has been removed from the "Classic Report."
- Account Report prints with Applied Credit hidden or in view.
- Print Setup properly prints Fringe report.
- Fringe Breakdown Summary Report displays properly round amounts.

#### **User Interface and Navigation**

- The change value in the budget status bar now updates as per CMMB.
- Adjusting the column width at the Accounts level no longer changes the column width settings at the Top Sheet level.
- In the CMMB keyboard, the left arrow key now functions correctly in all detail cells.
- In the CMMB keyboard, any new line added beneath an existing fringe range will be included in that fringe range.
- In CMMB keyboard, the F10 key now properly advances to the next account.
- In the CMMB keyboard, the Ctrl+~ behaves identically to CMMB 5.7.

## Globals

- When a Global used in another Global's calculation is deleted, the system now automatically recalculates when focus is moved outside of the global table.

## Fringes

- In Setup Fringes, Fringe Benefit by Percentage is now the default display.

## KNOWN ISSUES

---

### General

- **Issue:** Transferring the Application to a New Hard Drive. When moving to a new hard drive and the application is copied to it, the licensing system will encounter errors. This action is especially common on a Mac®.

**Workaround:** Deactivate the application and write down the activation ID before transferring the data from an old hard drive to new one. You will need to re-enter your Activation ID on the new hard drive after the transfer. For any licensing issues, please contact Product Support for assistance.

- **Issue:** Transferring the Application to a New Computer. When moving to a new computer and the application is copied to it, the licensing system will encounter errors.

**Workaround:** Deactivate the application and write down the activation ID before transferring the data from an old hard drive to new one. You will need to re-enter your Activation ID on the new hard drive after the transfer. For any licensing issues, please contact Product Support for assistance.

- **Issue:** When copying and pasting cells within a line and pasting them to another account, it has been reported to take longer than usual periods of time to paste.

**Workaround:** Copy and paste the entire line. If at all possible, copy and paste the entire line(s) of data. Selecting the entire line avoids this issue.

- **Issue:** When trying to remove a Group's ID, the ID seems to be removed, but when the setup window is re-opened the Group ID is still there.

**Workaround:** Create a new Group without the ID and do a Find/Replace to replace all the instances of the Group. Then delete the original Group.

- **Issue:** If two or more budgets are opened and one of them is a new template, sometimes changes made to any of these budgets will not be saved.

**Workaround:** Individually save changes made in each budget before opening a new template.



- **Issue:** When selecting **File > New** on a Mac®, the application does not go automatically to the Template folder.  
**Workaround:** Navigate to the Template folder.
- **Issue:** Ctrl + (NUMPAD7) does not display memory usage.  
**Workaround:** Windows® users can view memory usage through Task Manager. There is no workaround for Mac® users.
- **Issue:** Fringe and Global values do not calculate correctly in Windows® OS when working in European locales.  
**Workaround:** Change system locales to English (United States) when running MMB.
- **Issue:** Mac® F9, F10, and F11. Mac® F9, F10, and F11 are not functioning due to Mac® OS.  
**Workaround:** Change the keys being used by the Mac® OS or use the shortcut keys created in MMB for those functions.
- **Issue:** Budget Comparison window does not display properly in 800 x 600 screen resolution.  
**Workaround:** Change the screen resolution to 1024 x 768.
- **Issue:** If you use cut/paste in the 4th Level, an “undo” of cells works properly. However, “redo” may break any formulas you have used.  
**Workaround:** Reapply formulas.

## Printing

- **Issue:** When using the built in PDF generator in the Mac® version of MMB, the grid lines may extend to the edges of the page.  
**Workaround:** Use the Mac® PDF generator instead. Go to print the document, and in the print dialog there is a PDF button. Select “Save as PDF.”
- **Issue:** The Default column width is too wide, causing the last column of the Budget Comparison Report to print on two pages.  
**Workaround:** Manually adjust the column width.
- **Issue:** When creating a PDF of an export message, the application stops responding and does not create a PDF of the export message.  
**Workaround:** Choose “Select All” and copy/paste to notepad.



- **Issue:** In Windows® Vista®, printing within the setup tables abruptly shuts down EP Budgeting if a printer other than the default printer is selected. This is because some printers may not work properly on Windows® Vista®.

**Workaround:** Select the default printer when printing setup tables in the Windows® Vista® operating system.

## Importing/Exporting

- **Issue:** Rounding differences between MMB and CMMB.

**Workaround:** MMB rounds at the Account Level, while CMMB rounds at the Top sheet Level. Expect a difference of plus (+) or minus (-) X per Account in MMB. To find Detail lines where differences occur, open the exported CMMB file in MMB, and then save it under a different name. The budget comparison feature can be run to find the differences.

- **Issue:** When exporting files to CMMB format, only the Base and Conversion currencies will be imported to the CMMB Currency Table. Other currencies will be exported as Globals. If a Global of the same name exists and neither the Global nor the Currency is renamed, the value of the original Global will be used wherever this Global is applied. This can create a discrepancy; likewise, if the MMB file is reopened later in EPB.

**Workaround:** If importing/exporting between MMB and CMMB is a part of your normal workflow, refrain from using the Currency column in MMB. Express currencies as Globals with the appropriate values to avoid conflicts with existing Globals.

- **Issue:** In CMMB, a % symbol in the Units field is cosmetic only. In MMB, the % symbol acts as a multiplier when applied to a Detail line. This may cause discrepancies when importing/exporting budgets between the two programs.

**Workaround:** In CMMB, replace any % symbol existing in the Globals Units field with the number one (1) before exporting/importing.

- **Issue:** Copying a non-adjacent row from an Excel® file to MMB 4th Level does not working every time.

**Workaround:** Open Excel® first and then copy something to the clipboard prior to opening MMB.

## No Workarounds Available at this Time

- When using the CMMB keyboard setting, the top row of View/Apply dialogue boxes appears “selected” until the user makes a View/Apply choice.
- As in CMMB Flat-rate fringes may incorrectly cut off when applied to multiple lines in a single fringe range.
- Details subtotal column differs by plus (+) or minus (-) 1 from the actual printed report.
- Column headers on the 4th Level report do not print.



- Referencing a nonexistent cell in the 4th Level will produce an error, but no error message.
- When using the import/export feature between MMB7 and CMMB, the Original and Variance columns between the two applications show differences due to the different rounding methodologies between the two programs.
