### WHAT'S NEW IN THIS RELEASE

---

- Element linking now works retroactively.
- Addition of a summary window for Total Pages, Total Shooting Days and End of Production Date.
- Users can now reorder the schedules and they will appear that way in the dropdown window.
- Enhancements to the functionality of the DOOD including travel days.
- Repairs to the functionality of the Image Manager.
- The ability to add images to any report.
- The designer adds the ability to use dotted lines.
- The ability to auto schedule by time as well as page count.
- Importing screenwriting files are no longer case sensitive.

### KNOWN ISSUES

---

- When closing the application and then canceling the request to close (by selecting the "No" button), the application will still close and any recent changes will not be saved.
- The Microsoft® XPS document format is not supported.
